

Harry's Hampshire Interactive Map is a unique product created by Eastleigh Tec Hub members Blue Donut Studios and SplashMaps, commissioned by Road To Agincourt and funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund.

The beautiful map - which is printed on fabric so it can be worn as a scarf or bandana - uses the latest technology to highlight the role Hampshire played in the build up and aftermath of the Battle of Agincourt. Using augmented reality, the map is imbedded with tales from the past and information of the significant role the region played in King Henry V's reign. Historical points transform into animations complete with tales from the past and key information of the role the region played in the lead up to the battle.
